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Step 1: Verify Minimum Requirements

Step 2: Run Hollander Interchange Update

This procedure takes place on the Windows desktop of the Powerlink Server or Primary PC.

1. Sign-in to the PowerStation server using a **Manager Account**.
2. Make sure everyone is logged out of Powerlink and that there are no open Powerlink sessions. For more information, see [Appendix A](#).
3. Close all programs.
4. [Click here to download Interchange Release 85.02](#).
5. Click **Run** to download the file.
6. Click **Run** to start the Interchange update.
7. Click **Next** to continue.
8. Read the License Agreement, select **I accept the terms of the license agreement**, then click **Next**.
If you do not accept this License Agreement, the install will terminate.
9. Click **Install** to start the update.
10. Several informational dialog boxes will flash on the screen.



Average run time is between 15 and 30 minutes.

11. Click **Finish**.
12. Once the update is complete, we strongly recommend rebooting the PowerStation server.

Verify the Update was Successful

From the **Help** menu in Powerlink, select **About Powerlink**. If the update was successful, the version number displays **Interchange: 85.02**.

Step 3: Run Verify & Update

As Hollander gathers information about new models, we also improve the old Hollander Interchange. When we receive additional

information about a part or modify the Hollander Interchange for efficiency, the numbers change. As a result, your inventory numbers must be changed to correspond with the new numbers. The update process converts those numbers that may be changed without your review. However, not all numbers can automatically be changed, hence the need to run Verify & Update.

Verify and Update is IMPORTANT!

Once you have completed the Interchange update, please start the Verify and Update process as soon as possible, as you will not be able to find all of your inventory until the process is complete.

These topics can be found in the **Contents** tab of the **Powerlink Help** system, or you can press <F1> from any Powerlink dialog box to get a detailed description of each of the fields within the open dialog box.

Appendix A

Log everyone out of Powerlink and close all instances of Powerlink

1. From the **Start** menu, select **Utilities > Task Manager**, and then click the **Users** tab.
2. Select the user you want to log off of the system, and then click **Logoff**.
Repeat this step until all of the users except you have been logged off. Remember, you must be a member of the Administrators in order to logoff a user.
3. Click on the **Processes** tab.
4. Click the **Image Name** column to sort the contents in alphabetical order.
5. Look for any instances of **Powerlink.exe**. For each instance, select it and then click **End Process**.
6. When you're finished, click the **X** in the top right corner of the dialog box to close the Task Manager.
